RSSF Scholarship Guidelines

How do I apply?

Complete and submit your application along with a copy of your most recent 1040 tax return for proof of household income. Each student must complete an essay, and do either a video or in-person audition to complete the process.

The scholarship committee will review applications and conduct an interview with the student and his or her parent or guardian before a scholarship is granted.

Do I qualify for financial aid?

Financial aid is intended for students ages 7 – 18 who cannot otherwise pay for monthly tuition. The amount of assistance is based upon the household income.

Qualified candidates must know:

Students receiving financial aid are expected to attend 100% of lessons and rehearsals except due to illness. Poor attendance may result in termination of financial aid.

The maximum amount of financial aid is 100% of tuition and the lowest amount awarded is 25%.

Candidates must demonstrate commitment to learning to play their instrument and be a contributing member of the student body. They are expected to help out around the school, and to strictly adhere to the code of conduct for the school they attend.

Parents of scholarship students may be asked to volunteer up to 6 hours per month at the school.

Scholarships will be paid directly to the Rock School on behalf of the student, and the Rock School will provide RSSF with a quarterly report on the student's progress. A negative report from the Rock School may result in termination of financial aid.

Balance of tuition is due to the Rock School per the terms of their enrollment agreement with the student, but in general, tuition is paid monthly.

How do I renew my financial aid?

Financial aid must be renewed on six month basis. If a student leaves the program before the six months is up, and later wish to reapply, they may do so, but must go through the entire application process again. Renewal forms should be submitted by the end of the fifth month.
